Opportunities for Students

During the meeting, several PwC programs were outlined in which students could apply and participate in.

- Career Preview
 - Available for Freshman
 - A three-day program, where participants will work alongside peers to learn actively about themselves, the world of professional services and PwC.
 - This program is designed for high-performing college freshmen/rising sophomores who self-identify as members of traditionally underrepresented minority groups in the professional services industry, protected veterans, and/or individuals with disabilities
- Explore
 - Available for Freshman and Sophomores
 - Explore is a one-day program focused on helping participants identify and analyze their strengths to better understand who they are and potential career opportunities.
- Start Internship
 - Available for Sophomores and Juniors
 - Selected students for this internship will learn about the professional services industry. They will also have the opportunity to develop professional and

technical skills necessary for success in the business world by working with teams across PwC's internal functions

- Challenge
 - Available for Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors
 - PwC's case competition which models real-world business scenarios focusing on the strategic issues currently being faced by companies all over the world. It is open to all freshmen and sophomores (and juniors in a 5 year program) and does not require detailed knowledge of business concepts or accounting
- Elevate
 - Available for Sophomores and Juniors
 - PwC's Elevate program is designed for prospective interns to experience PwC's culture first-hand, while building relationships with professionals and learning more about how PwC is innovating
